



# TOURING GUIDELINES

Each automobile touring with OVAC or being displayed as representing OVAC **MUST HAVE:**

- Proof of insurance\*
- Safety Glass\*
- Working emergency brake\*
- Working stop light(s)\*
- Fire extinguisher

\* These are all items currently required by the "Revised Code of Washington" (RCW's).

## RECOMMENDED:

- Turn indicator lights
- Seat belts

Each member (at time of membership renewal or each new member) will be required to sign an application/renewal form stating that they have read and understand the above safety rules. This will then be kept on file by the OVAC Secretary.

## Touring / Display Eligibility

Automobiles are to be 30 or more years old. This is in line with Washington State licensing requirements. Each automobile is to appear as originally manufactured with original type running gear and original type suspension. Accessories of the era may be added.

## Automobiles that do not qualify

- Hot Rods
- Street Rods
- Customized Cars
- Reproduction / Kit cars

## Grandfathered Automobiles.

All automobiles in the OVAC roster as of 2003 are grandfathered in. Each of the recommendations above received a unanimous vote from the committee members present and received a majority vote from OVAC membership present during the February 2003 meeting.
